



The census questionnaire takes less than 10 minutes to complete. Census takers will never ask for your Social Security number, bank information or proof of citizenship. They just want to know how many people are residing in your household.

Census forms are available in 14 languages by phone and over 59 languages for assistance online.

**Complete the census now, even without an ID.**



## Over the next decade, we could lose out on:

- **\$19,100** in federal allocations for one missed resident
- **\$44,312** to ND for one missed household (average 2.32 persons)
- **\$15 million** is lost to ND, if our count is off by 0.1%

That's taxpayer dollars that is reallocated towards other states that could otherwise support critical programs across North Dakota.

## What is the census and why does it matter?

The U.S. Census Bureau is constitutionally mandated with the task of counting all people living in the United States. This helps communities plan for their residents needs.

This data has been collected every 10 years since 1790; it is used to determine how billions of dollars in federal funding flow into states and communities like yours each year.

In North Dakota, we receive more than:

**\$1.8 billion** in federal funds each year that are determined by census counts.

That's over

**\$19,000** per person back into your community over a decade.

Health clinics, schools, food shelters, roads and infrastructure projects are all funded by the answers collected in the census.

All data collected in the census is kept confidential by law for 72 years. None of your personal information will ever be shared with other government agencies.

## The 2020 census is important to North Dakota.

The makeup of political representation and flow of taxpayer dollars are based upon how many residents are counted in the census. If your household isn't counted, your community loses!

This has major impacts in ND. The census count directs more than \$1.8 billion to North Dakota every year.
